Players Code of Conduct

- The Academy expects the highest standard of behavior, personal appearance and manners at all times.
- Ensure you are punctual and report to your coach in good time and always ask your coach before you leave the premises.
- It is the parents and players responsibility to ensure they come prepared for the Academy every week.
- Boots, shin guards and water must be brought to all academy sessions and matches.
- Parents are not permitted to approach the coaches directly with problems. This must be done via the academy director Thomas Mc Stravick on thomas@playingforthefuture.co.uk
- Academy will be available to purchase at the start of training. This purchase is not compulsory.
- If purchased only Academy kit to be worn at all sessions and matches. Any kit lost must be replaced as soon as possible.
- Players should maintain high levels of personal hygiene.
- Earrings or jewellery are not permitted at any time.
- Players should never abuse match officials or any of the coaching staff. Players will be asked to leave the Academy if this rule is breached.
- Behavior such as spitting at an opponent, retaliation or swearing will not be tolerated at any time.
- The use of verbal, racial or physical abuse will not be tolerated at any time.
- All injuries (whether before the Academy session or during the Academy) must be reported to the Head Coach Chris. Treatment will only be administered by Academy Medical Staff.
- Selection for Tournaments and Trips will depend on the attendance at the Academy.
- Whether at home or away respect MUST be shown to Club facilities and property at all times. All areas must be kept tidy and equipment stored away safely – any damage will not be tolerated
- Player MUST refrain from using social media to express their views that would bring the academy into disrepute. Any views deemed offensive or derogatory by members of the Academy will not be tolerated and may mean instant dismissal from the Academy
